WHAT IS LEVEL UP?

The **LEVEL UP** program at Lackawanna College was created in response to the national crisis related to the **rising cost of higher education**, the **increased time that students spend in college** before completing their degree, and the need for students to **graduate from their secondary experience** prepared to succeed in a major program of their choice.

By creating a new model that offers students **concrete educational pathways during their high school experience**, the College aims to reduce or eliminate barriers to enrollment in higher education, boost student retention and completion rates, and link early educational pipelines with family-sustaining careers for students of all socioeconomic backgrounds.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible to enroll in the Level Up program, students must meet the following criteria:

- Maintain a 3.0 GPA for certificate programs or a 3.25 GPA for associate degree programs
- Meet minimum PSAT or SAT scores. Minimum scores are based on the College Board's College and Career Readiness Benchmarks
- Successfully complete Lackawanna's College 101 course.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Level Up offers multiple approaches to higher education achievement. Students can choose pathways that include a combination of dual enrollment credits offered at a reduced cost on-site through partner districts or via online, late afternoon, evening, and summer classes at Lackawanna College.

EARN AN ASSOCIATE DEGREE WHILE STILL IN HIGH SCHOOL

- Applicable majors include **Business Administration, Criminal Justice, Human Services, and Professional Studies**.
- **Total cost of an associate degree will be \$6,200** - a significant savings versus traditional tuition at any institution, with opportunities to have the program fully funded - potentially making it free to students!
- If students decide to continue their education at Lackawanna College after graduating from high school, the cost paid by the student towards their Level Up coursework will be **returned to them as a scholarship towards their bachelor's degree**.

COMPLETE GROUPS OF COMPETENCY COURSES FOR TRANSFERABLE CREDITS

- Students can pursue discipline-specific certificates comprised of introductory and foundation level courses in particular majors.
- Certificates available in **Business Administration, Criminal Justice, Cybersecurity, Human Services, and Professional Studies**.
- These discipline-specific bundles of courses will save students at least one semester of college work at a **cost of \$1,800-\$2,100**.

BUILD A PATHWAY TO A HEALTHCARE CAREER

- Course collections designed to strengthen the academic skills of students interested in **pursuing a career in healthcare**.
- **Develop mentoring opportunities** between Lackawanna's healthcare students and high school students curious about the industry.
- Offers students the ability to take prerequisite and foundation courses while still in high school, including **biology, anatomy and physiology, medical terminology**, and more.
- **Preferential associate program admission** to graduates of the pipeline program.

PNG PIPELINE

- Available beginning in the Fall 2019 semester, students can explore exciting career opportunities in the petroleum and natural gas industries.
- This 21-credit pathway will introduce students to some of the technology and physics necessary to be successful in this field.

SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE!

Lackawanna is excited to offer a scholarship to assist with the cost of Level Up coursework. Scholarships will be awarded annually and will assist with the cost of courses taken online or on campus.
